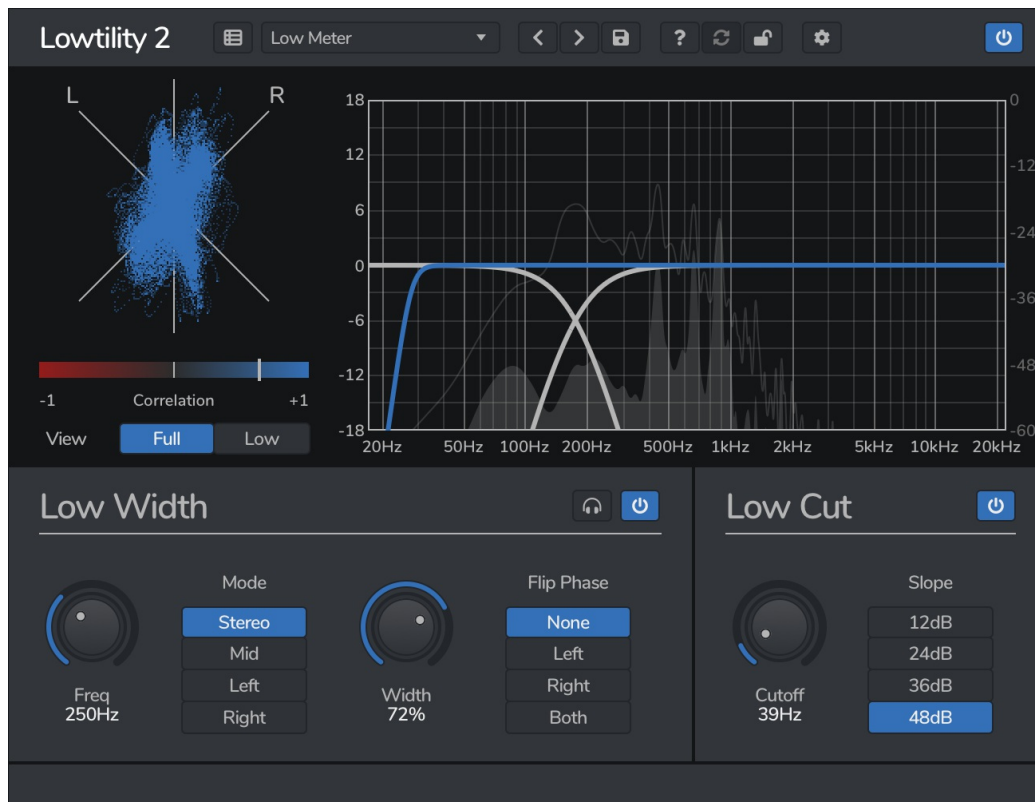


Lowtility 2

v2.1.5



Lowtility 2 is a low-end filter and mid/side utility plugin. Lowtility 2 lets you cleanly cut the low frequencies from your mix, and modify the stereo field. You can cut the low frequencies using a variable slope low-cut filter, reduce the stereo width of the low end, or completely make it mono, using either the mid channels or one of the side channels.

Installing Lowtility 2

To install Lowtility 2 on **Mac** or **Windows**, simply run the installer and follow the instructions. Once installed, Lowtility 2 will be ready to use the next time you open your DAW.

To install the plugin on **Linux**, simply extract the files and run the install.sh script. In your Terminal app, run the following commands:

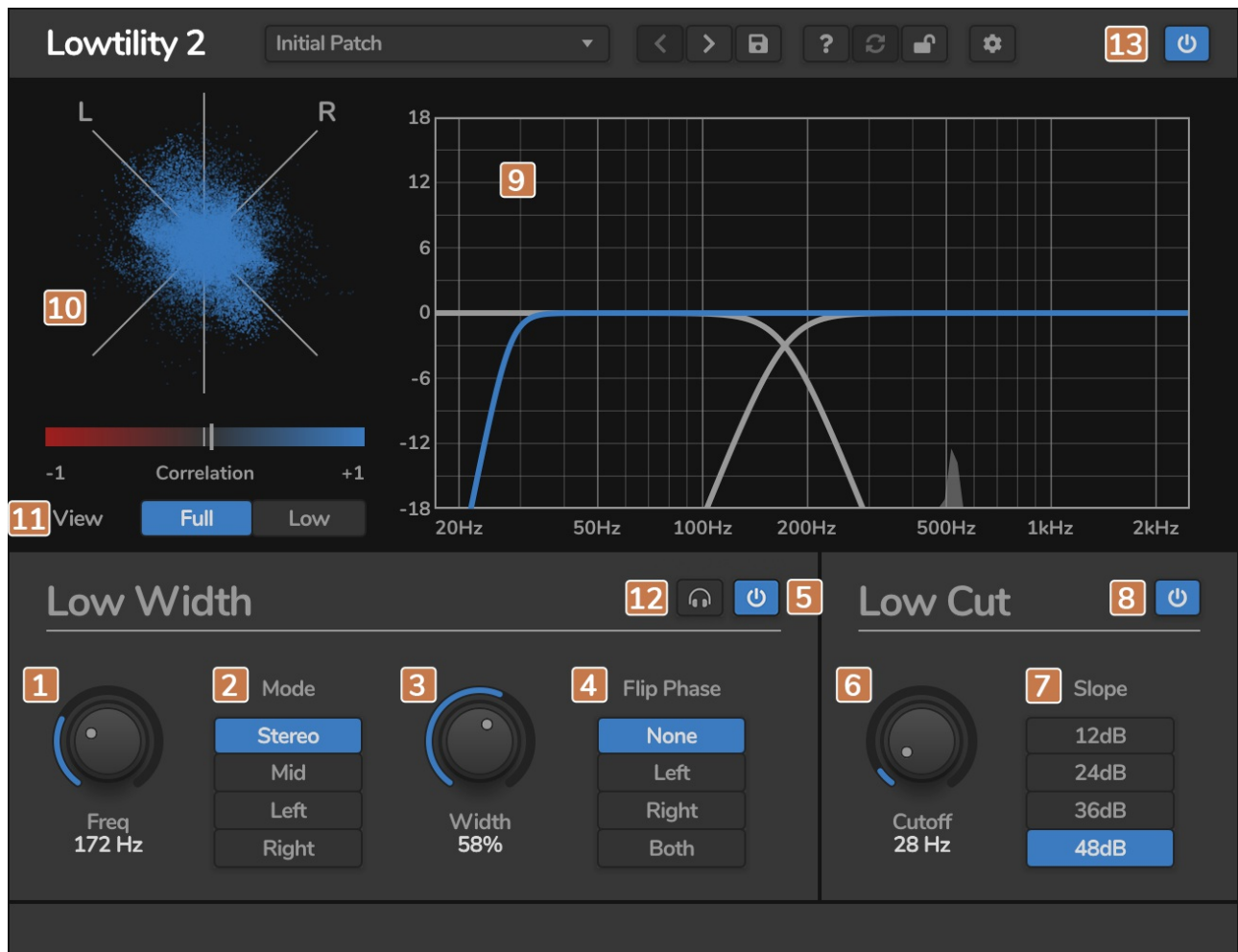
Registering Lowtility 2

The plugin will run in demo mode until a licence is entered and the software is restarted. In demo mode the plugin will not recall the state from a saved track, it will timeout after 30 minutes, and the saving of presets is unavailable. After you have purchased a licence, you will need to register the plugin, which will unlock the full, unrestricted version of the software. Any tracks you have saved with the demo version will now recall correctly.

Click the padlock icon in the top bar area of the plugin window. A window will display where you can enter your licence from the Venomode website user area. After you have entered your licence, the full version will unlock the next time you open your DAW.

From the Venomode website, you can either copy the licence to your clipboard and paste it in the plugin, or download a keyfile and open in the plugin to register.

Using Lowtility 2



1. Frequency Knob

This is where you can set the crossover frequency for the filters. The range is from 20Hz to 2kHz. Any frequency below this value is in the low band and will be controlled in this section. Anything above will be left untouched.

2. Stereo Mode

The stereo mode selection lets you choose how Lowtility handles the stereo width of your low frequency band. In 'Stereo' mode, the band remains in stereo, and the width can be adjusted with the 'Width' knob.

In 'Mid' mode, it mixes both left and right channels down to mono. In 'L' and 'R' modes, it outputs only the left or right channel respectively. You may find some audio has phase issues when mixing to mono, so selecting one of the side channels may result in a more coherent sound.

3. Width

The width knob is only active when the 'Mode' is set to 'Stereo'. When at 100%, the stereo field remains unaffected. As you move closer to 0%, the stereo field narrows into the centre. At 0% the signal is completely mono.

4. Flip Phase

This options lets you flip the phase of the low band signal. 'None' will not affect the signal. 'Left' and 'Right' will flip the left and right channels respectively, and 'Both' will invert the phase of both channels.

5. Enable Width Section

This toggle will enable or disable the width section.

6. Filter Cutoff

This is where you can set the cutoff frequency for the low cut filter. The range is from 20Hz to 2kHz. Any frequency below this value will be cut from the signal.

7. Slope Selection

The slope of the filter measures how fast the low frequencies roll off. The 12dB option is a gentle slope using a 2-pole filter. The 24dB option is the default option using a 4 pole filter. The 36dB and 48dB filters are steep for getting closer to a brick wall response.

8. Enable Low Cut Section

This toggle will enable or disable the low cut filter section.

9. Filter Graph

The filter graph shows the current state of the filter. The blue line shows the frequency response of the low cut filter. The grey lines shows the crossover point for the low width band. The X axis shows the frequency from 20Hz to 2kHz. The Y axis shows gain in decibels, from -18dB to 18dB.

10. Stereo Meters

The top section shows a goniometer, using a Lissajous figure to display the stereo field. A completely mono signal will show as a vertical blue line in the centre. A signal completely on the left or right will show as a 45° line on either the L or R axis. A stereo signal will spread across the entire graph.

The lower section shows a correlation meter, with a moving bar to show the current phase correlation. When fully in the blue section at the right (+1), the signal is fully in phase and is essentially mono. As the meter moves towards the centre grey area, the signal has more of a stereo spread. In the centre, the signal is as wide as is possible without becoming out of phase. As the meter enters the red zone, the signal becomes out of phase. At the fully left side (-1) the signal is completely out of phase, and summing to mono will end up with a phase cancelled signal. For a clean signal, aim to keep the meter in the right (blue) half of the meter.

11. View Mode

Here you can set what the Gonio and Correlation meters are displaying. 'Full' will show the full stereo signal, and 'Low' will only show the signal in the low band of the 'Low Width' section.

12. Audition Width

Enabling this will audition the low width section. The high end of the crossover, and the cut section will be bypassed.

13. Top Bar

The top bar is where you can manage the plugin. The middle section shows the currently selected preset, and if you open this list you can choose from all the factory and user presets. Clicking on the left and right arrow icons manually cycles to the previous or next preset. The save icon will open a window where you can save the current state of the plugin as a custom preset. Enter your preset name in this window and click save.

You can view this manual at any time by clicking the question mark button.

The padlock icon will open the registration window. Enter your licence code exactly as shown in your Venomode user area and click "Register". You can simply click the licence in your Venomode account to copy it to your clipboard. See the registering Lowtility 2 section for more info.

The cog icon will open a settings window where you can alter the GPU acceleration settings, GUI scale and theme. The update icon is two arrows in a circle. This button will activate when a new version is available for download.

The top right icon with a power button symbol will enable or disable the plugin.

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
